The First Amendment to the U.S. Constitution does not require ministers to perform marriages that are contrary to their faith. The doctrine of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints holds that marriage is between a man and a woman. Consistent with that fundamental belief, the Church does not perform marriages between two people of the same sex. Church policy also precludes the use of Church meetinghouses or properties for ceremonies, receptions, or other events associated with same-sex marriage. God loves all of His children and the Church respects those with different opinions but its position on marriage is clear and unchanging.
