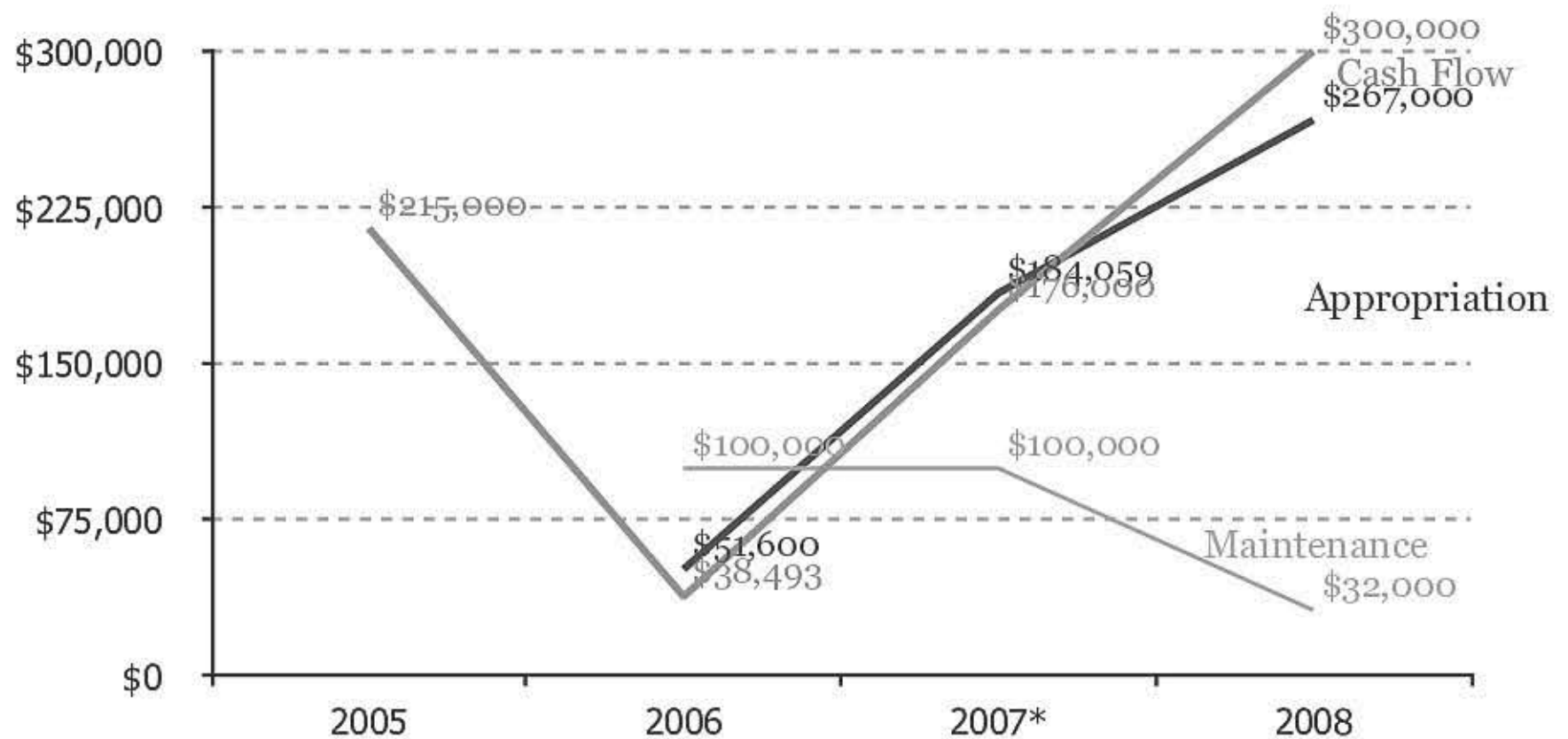
Objectives

This will streamline IT resolutions allowing resources to be focused on working with students and providing them with a quality CES experience.▪ Permanent data connectivity has been established between the BYU data systems and CPC Provo.▪ Authentication processes for WISE has been implemented through LDS Account. The user experience was difficult with the initial rollout and caused some delay in additional rollouts. Most of the issues have been resolved and authentication using LDS Account will be rolled to additional areas.▪ Work continued in '07 on the Decision Support System (DSS). DSS version 3 was released during the year with a version 4 well into the planning phase.▪ The addition of a comprehensive website search to LDSCES.org has allowed users to more easily find content that helps them to understand the gospel and its precepts.▪ Significant progress has been made integrating CES with PeopleSoft HR.
