1. Describe a setback you have encountered in your life. Explain how you have handled the situation and what you have learned from it.
2. Please share your reasons for seeking admission as a Transfer student – we invite you specifically to address your intended major or program of study, and your career/life ambitions.
3. Tell us anything else you want us to know about yourself that you haven't had the opportunity to describe elsewhere in the application.

International applicants will also answer the following question:

Describe how you plan to enrich the environment at the LDS church college/university you hope to attend, and how you will contribute back to your family, community and the Church upon leaving this school.
