1. **GPA:** take the unweighted GPA (as determined by BYU) and multiply by 10
2. **ACT:** actual ACT composite score or SAT equivalent on the *Critical Reading* and *Math* sections
3. **Years of Seminary:** add .75 for each seminary year completed
4. **Seminary Recommendation:** add .75 if *Strongly Recommended* or *Recommended*; no points for *Recommend with Reservations* or *Do Not Recommend*
5. **Bishop:** add 3.0 points if endorsed with a *Yes*; no points for *Yes, with Reservations* or *No*
6. **Stake President:** add 1.50 points if endorsed with *Yes*; no points for *Yes, with Reservations* or *No*
7. **Extracurricular Activities:** points are accrued according to the guide for Part 6; note that each category does not accumulate TOTAL points – points are awarded only for the highest point value marked in each category; total is capped at 7.0
8. **Geographical Area:** add 1.50 points for Alaska and for locales east of Colorado
9. **Small School:** add .75 points if the graduating class is composed of 100 students or less
10. **First Generation:** add .50 points if BOTH parents have no more than *Some College* as the highest education level; add 1.5 points if BOTH parents have no more than *High School Graduate* as the highest education level.
11. **Special Interest:** add 1.0 for male applicants
12. **AP or IB:** add .25 for each AP or IB class for each enrolled semester (one class for one year = .50 points)
13. **Priority:** add 1.0 point if the applicant meets the December 1 Priority Deadline

1. **Transfer EGPA:** take the reconfigured total college GPA and multiply by 10
2. **Institute:** add 1.0 point if transferring from another CES school; or, add .25 pts for each institute class taken, capped at 1.0 point
3. **Mission:** add 2.0 points if applicant served a complete, full-time LDS church mission
4. **LDS:** add 1.0 point if a member of the LDS church
5. **Geographic:** add 1.0 point for high school locations in Alaska and east of Colorado
6. **First Generation:** add 1.0 point if BOTH parents have no more than *High School Graduate* as the highest education level
