Subject: Changes to JP Morgan Travel Rewards Program

The Church is transitioning from JP Morgan Chase (JPMC) travel credit cards, to a new program provided by the Bank of America (BofA). The move from JPMC was mandated when the bank would no longer support certain aspects of the Church's card program.

In the next few weeks, General Authorities will receive a new BofA travel credit card, which includes travel reward points for personal use. Although the JPMC cards will be discontinued when a new BofA card is issued, we expect to maintain your reward point balances on your JPMC card through June 30, 2013. We encourage you to redeem your JPMC reward points, as soon as possible. Go to https://www.yourcorporaterewards.com to access your rewards balance and set up your account.

To set up an account you will need your JPMC credit card, birthplace, mother's maiden name and work e-mail address. Once the account has been set up, you may redeem your JPMC reward points directly online. Many accounts have already been set up through Church Travel.
